CHOOSING YOUR PROTECTOR

Your protector can only protect you if it fits well. Try different sizes and choose the size that feels secure and comfortable on you. Choosing the right size of protector is very important. Refer to the table below and our website for a full explanation of sizing and positioning of the protector.

Positioning

When choosing your product make sure you select a left or right orientation.

Place on the front of lower leg and fasten straps behind leg so that pad is comfortable and firmly in position.

CRICKET GLOVES

Positioning

When choosing your product make sure you select a left or right orientation.

Place on hand and fasten straps around wrist so that gloves is comfortable and firmly in position.

Your protector has straps for tightening; please adjust as necessary for a good fit and maximum comfort. Please contact your local cricket specialist for assistance if needed. Every time you use your protector, check nothing is badly worn, torn, cracked or missing.

PRODUCT CARE

Do look after your protector. Misuse can impact the integrity of the product. Keep your protector away from chemicals. Store away from heat and sunlight. Alterations can reduce the strength and performance of your protector. To clean, wipe with a damp cloth. Avoid submersion in water.



REPLACING YOUR PROTECTOR

Dependent upon the regularity and severity of use, your protector should have a minimum service life of 3 years but please get a new protector if you can see or feel any damage or if it doesn't fit you anymore
